Global Business Services – Discover Africa’s delivery potential

The Global Business Services (GBS) industry is gaining momentum, driven by digitisation, remote work trends, and the increasing demand for specialised IT solutions. Across Africa, numerous countries have tapped into these developments by building strong and competitive Business Process Outsourcing (BPO) and Information Technology Outsourcing (ITO) ecosystems.

Outsourcing to Africa offers European companies strategic advantages. The continent is home to a large pool of **qualified talent**, with over 60% of the population under the age of 30 (UNDP Africa Youth Report 2023). This ensures long-term access to a skilled and adaptable workforce. Africa also benefits from **favorable time zones, strong language capabilities**—particularly in English and French—and **increasing investment in digital infrastructure**. Africa’s key offerings include also **cost-effective service delivery, a growing tech ecosystem, and a strong drive for innovation**.

These advantages position the continent as a **high-potential partner for IT and business services**. Morocco and Egypt have already become preferred outsourcing destinations in North Africa, while in Western Africa, countries like Ghana, Rwanda and Ethiopia are seeing a rise in BPO activities (Statista 2024).

Meanwhile, Europe — and Germany in particular — is facing a growing skilled labour shortage, especially in the IT sector with 149.000 vacant positions by 2030 (BITKOM). By tapping into Africa’s workforce, German and European companies can enhance efficiency, expand capacity, access high-quality services while addressing local talent shortages in a competitive global market.

To harness these opportunities and provide a solution to the problem of IT talent shortages in Europe, Invest for Jobs is organising a **GBS Roadshow in Germany, including participation at the GITEX Europe Tech Fair in Berlin from 19th to 23rd May 2025**. IT and BPO companies from Egypt, Ethiopia, Kenya, Morocco, Ghana and Rwanda will showcase their services, engage with potential clients, and lay the foundation for exploring new opportunities and building lasting partnerships.

By supporting these companies and building bridges between Africa and Europe, **Invest for Jobs aims to create good jobs** in its African partner countries. With the adoption of the “BMZ Agenda for Decent Work Worldwide” in 2023, digital transformation was recognised as a central pillar of decent employment. The strategy promotes fair wages, job security, and equal opportunities in digital industries — ensuring that technological change supports both economic growth and social well-being.

Africa’s GBS sector is already delivering impact: over 1 million people are currently employed in outsourcing roles (CCI Global Report). Roles in IT support, customer service, and back-office operations are offering youth across the continent long-term, future-proof employment. A study by CCI Global, in collaboration with Everest Group, forecasts that Africa’s GBS sector is poised to generate between 1 and 1.5 million jobs by 2030.
