1	3	Labour Migration	<p>What kind of documents have to be submitted for job placements in Germany?</p> <p>It is not necessary to submit signed Letters of Intent (LoI) from German Employers. However, a plausible explanation has to be provided of how and by whom (which partners) job placements In Germany can be achieved for the beneficiaries of the labour migration component. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cooperation with other initiatives, who are actively engaged in labour migration activities towards Germany and who demonstrate existing links with German employers, professional associations etc.</li> <li>• Cooperation with German professional associations, who have demonstrated their interest in supporting job placements in Germany.</li> <li>• Cooperation with specialized recruiting agencies, who can demonstrate their relationship with German employers in the respective occupational sectors.</li> </ul> <p>Please note that placement services must be based on recognised standards of fair recruitment, particularly with regard to transparency towards participants.</p>	23 April 2026
